### ADVENTURE

Venturing into the unknown, though rarely alone; learn by exploring

### CHOICE

Learning both concrete and abstract options such as going without so that another may benefit

### CLASSIFICATION

Using a known item or category to help understand new information

### COMPARISON

Learning to make sophisticated and in-depth comparisons

### CONSEQUENCE OF ACTION

Understanding the effects of personal actions on self or a group; admitting error and making amends; valuing fairness

### DISTANCE/TIME

Going forward and backwards in time and space

### HELPING

Helping peers and adults, awareness of contribution, the importance of the group

### INFORMATION

Understanding the source and uses of diverse information

### PROBLEM SOLVING

Learning how to plan, use resources, collect, classify, solve, finish; use tools

### SHARING

Sharing possessions, time and information; sharing affection for friends, adults

### CURIOSITY

Exploring the world around you; learning how things work and about the world around you

### IMAGINATIVE PLAY

Developing realism regarding people and characters, creating fantasy in the environment and situations

### GROWTH

Learning to change and adapt, empathy, right and wrong

### INDEPENDENCE

Solving problems with minimal adult help and supervision; pride in ability to plan and see a project through

### LANGUAGE

Understanding general word play including jokes and riddles

### PARTICIPATION

Cooperating with peers and adults

### RIGHT VS. WRONG

Distinguishing awareness of motivation; concern for fairness; basic understanding of other people's feelings

### SECURITY

Understanding that things do not have to be resolved perfectly; larger sense of group and belonging; sense of accomplishment

### SEQUENCE

Mastering processing steps, including planning and the use of resources and tools; flexibility in order
